performance requirements as directed by the LPFD Disaster Coordinator or RACES  
Radio Officers of Livermore and Pleasanton, California. I understand that my refusal or  
failure to complete any of the requirements shall result in the denial or termination of my  
position as Radio Operator with the LPFD RACES.

In accepting a position as a volunteer with the LPFD RACES, I understand and agree that  
I am serving without receiving any consideration and I have no vested property interest as  
a result of my position. Further, I understand and agree that my services as a volunteer  
may be terminated at any time without cause by a LPFD RACES Radio Officer, an  
official of the LPFD, or an official of the cities of Livermore or Pleasanton. I shall accept  
such termination if imposed.

In the event of my resignation from this position, or the voluntary or involuntary  
termination of my position, I shall promptly return all identification, documents, and  
equipment that may have been issued to me by the LPFD or RACES Radio Officer(s).
