

LARK Life Membership



With great pleasure and honor to announce that the Board formalized the LARK Life Membership process. The Board will make the decision on approving a LARK Member to become Life Member. The Klub's laws and by-laws will be adhered to for this process.

The Klub has two ways by which a member would become or honored a Life Member status.

- 1. Anyone who had been a LARK Member for 10 or more years, will have to request the Membership Chairperson for an adjustment of membership status to Life Member, by paying 20 years of membership dues via PayPal or check [in other words: 20 years times current membership dues per year is \$20 which would be a total of \$400.]. Upon receipt of the request, the Membership Chair will submit a filled-in Life Membership Form for the Board to approve. Based on approval, the roster will reflect the status as appropriate, and no more dues will be collected thereon for that member.
- 2. A LARK Member whose service to the Klub had been exceptional value, the Board would award the Member an Honorary Life Member status. The by-law permits no more than two members to be converted to Life Member status within a calendar year. The adjustment of membership status could happen at any part of the year.
























CQ World Wide CW - Roberto K6KM

Or: "How to make DXCC in less than 24hrs and with a good night sleep"

Last year I participated in this contest from Gary's: NA6O and Ian's: W6TCP station: W6SRR. It was a lot of fun and I made DXCC on the weekend on 800 QSOs. Checkout my report in the January 2022 LARK Newsletter.

My progression of QSOs has been:

2020: 22

2021: 400

2022: 800

This time I raised the bar a bit and wanted to score 1000 QSOs.

Family was alerted and accepted the reality that this was going to happen. The whole 48 hours were blocked but I would operate mostly during daylight hours as the low bands are not great right now and station's forte is on the high bands. Also I could get a nice 8 hour night sleep (8 hourish).

The beginning of the Contest was as usual, a blast. Propagation was very decent, participation healthy. 40m behaved and I swept EU not without the normal East Coast wall hurdle. 80m poor but enough to score Madeira Island and Japan. 160m poor as expected but I managed to make contact with a station in Honduras that was calling CQ idle and spent the time to copy me.

Saturday was a morning blast with an epic opening to EU on 15m and 20m. 10m was not great to EU at all this time. The solar flux has been coming down from the 170's to 110s and that hurt 10m propagation. Good news is that the geomagnetic field was very quiet for most of the weekend.

After the noon lunch and some world cup soccer entertainment I returned for some JA and SA action. JA was everywhere and easy to work. That is our advantage on the West Coast. I still have to figure out why JA's send their call sign twice when calling CQ. Seems like a lot of time wasted. Late afternoon 40m was not as nice as the previous day but managed to keep the count. Sunday morning had a decent opening to EU but with obviously fewer stations. Afternoon the JA's were on their Monday morning, so many had gone to work.

Saturday afternoon I checked and I was DXCC=101, so DXCC in less than 24 hours with 8 hour sleep. Final DXCC count 113. Some other interesting statistics: 30% of QSOs from EU. 20% from JA.

This is one of my favorite contests as it's CW and DX.

Thanks to lan and Gary for the use of their fine Remote Station.
